

Official Pageant Rules:

NO EXPERIENCE NEEDED for this Natural Beauty Pageant. There will be no talent portion & no interview segment.

1. The pageant is Saturday, July 16, 2016 at 11am at Tiddlywinks Baby & Family Fair at the Wilma Rudolph Event Center located at [1190 Cumberland Drive in Clarksville, TN](#)
2. **Contestants must be checked in between 10am to 10:45am or you will not be allowed to participate.**
3. Regular [Registration](#) deadline is 11:59pm on Friday, July 1, 2016. Each age group has a limited number of participant slots available – first come, first serve.
4. Contestants will be judged on beauty, poise and personality.
5. Attire must be formal and must be floor length. No exposed midriffs.
6. Contestants must pay a \$35 non-refundable entry fee if [registered](#) before Friday, July 1, 2016. Late registration costs \$50 and are taken until July 14, 2016 at 11:59PM.
7. Round 1 is Dressy/Formal Clothes (One Outfit Only). We prefer very little to no makeup and age appropriate clothing. Girls: Short or long dress, party dress, pageant dress or gown. Any type of formal wear dress. Boys: Dressy clothes. May have short or long pants.
8. Round 2: Express Yourself Clothes (One Outfit Only.) Girls & Boys: This is your child's chance to show the judges their personality. Sports Fans, Girly Girls, Sparkles or Preppy – let your son or daughter pick the outfit that best represents their own unique sense of style.

What do the Contestants do at the pageant?

Starting with Baby Miss and Mr. Clarksville, each member of the age group will go out on stage individually (in numeric order) in "Formal Wear." The pageant will move through the age groups for the formal wear portion and then start again with the youngest age group in the "Express Yourself" category.

Each age group will be called to the stage and winners announced for Most Photogenic, Best Eyes, Best Smile & Grand Supreme winners will be awarded.

- Infant/Baby (0-4):
 - In baby pageants, a parent is allowed to stand on stage behind the child. For non-walkers, the parent holds the child up for the judges to see. Judges look for:
 - Award winning smile
 - Natural beauty/cuteness
 - Overall Appeal
 - Parents may do what they can to help their infant/baby to smile for the judges/crowd.
 - Toddler/Young Children (4 and up):
 - They look at [a contestant's] appearance
 - Ability to stand in front of a crowd without being shy (Onstage Presence)
 - Smile
 - Natural Beauty/cuteness
 - Overall Appeal

Whether or not a judge hands your child a tiara, the most important aspect of the pageant is to have fun! The time you and your child spend working together toward a goal will make lifelong memories!
